- ❖ How will limited ACT/SAT testing opportunities impact my student's chances of admission?

- What is the new COVID question on the Common App and should my student respond to it?
- Does it matter who my student asks to be his/her teacher recommenders?
- Has the pandemic impacted my student's chances of admission at public vs. private schools?
